This activity lasts for 5 days starting from 5<sup>th</sup> - 10 January 2020, which is located in India.

The beginning of 2020 was lucky for Bariq and Khoirunnisa because they were able to represent Indonesia, especially as representatives of the BK Asian Medical Students' Association (AMSA) FK UPNVJ in this prestigious event which was able to win 1st place in a *public poster* entitled *First Aid Burn Injuries with 'GET 4C' at the East Asian Medical Students' Conference (EAMSC 2020) : India* with the theme *'Emergency Medicine: When Seconds Count'*. This activity was attended by medical faculty students from 11 countries and on an international scale. The number of participants who took part in this competition were 44 participants from 11 tertiary institutions with different countries and in particular 24 participants took part in the field of *public posters*.
