Dr. Rachman Sjarief explained many things related to *Theory U*, "æ Transformational Leadership; Idealized influence , Inspirational motivation , Intellectual simulation , and Individual consideration . Transformational Leadership Theory U , starting from observing three times to see a lot and talk a little - in the middle of contemplating, planning for the future - then rising to action. In addition there are 5 U Processes: Stages otto scharmer, Co-initiating: Downloading uncover common intent , Co-sensing: observe, observe, observe , Presencing: Connect to the source of inspiration and will , Co-Creating: prototype the new and Co -evolving: embody the new in ecosystem.

In addition, Dr. Rachman Sjarief also gave *Theory U* leadership tips in modern times like this, "æ There are several Theory U leadership tips in modern times like today; Becoming a source of inspiration - " walk the talk ", Listening (empathic listening and generative listening), Doing "co-sensing" blusukan, Doing "presencing" introspection, "retreat-reflecting", muhasabah, Doing letting go - letting come , Doing " co-creating " and " co-evolving " and Maintaining a Growth Mindset and Innovative .
