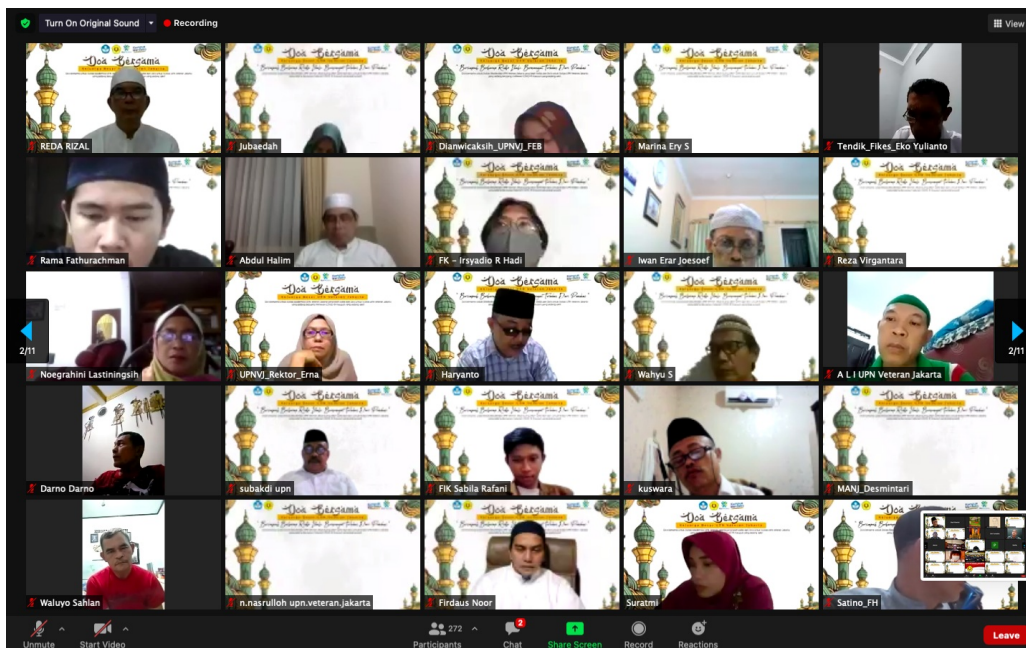


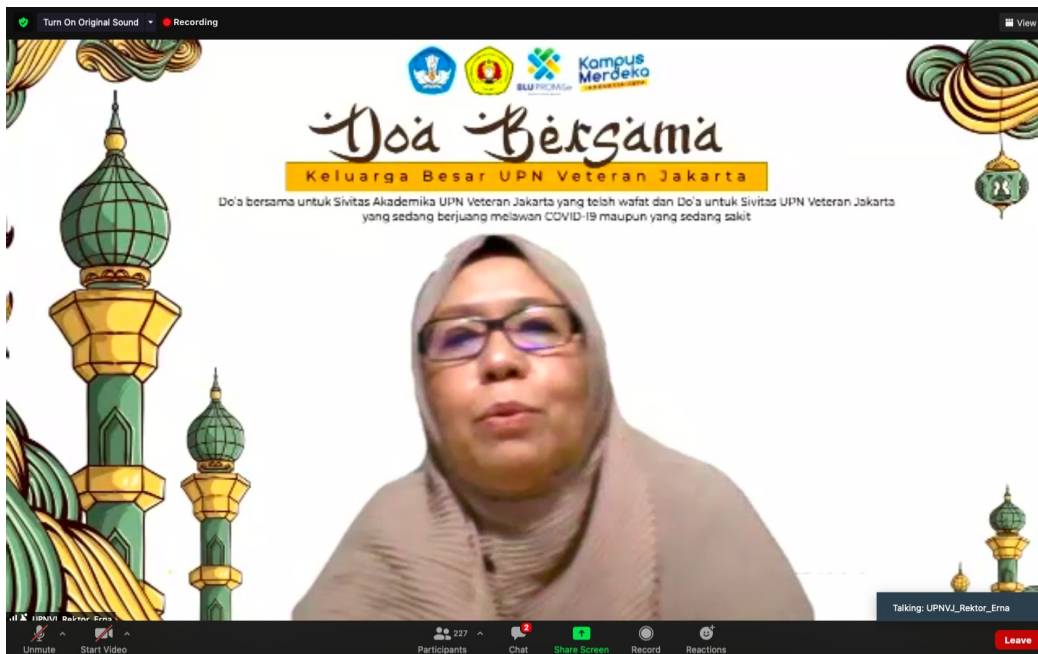
# Lots of Grief in the Midst of a Pandemic, UPNVJ Holds a Joint Prayer
