Kazakhstan, a country that is geographically located in the Central Asian region along with Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Kyrgyzstan is a country that was previously under the influence of the Soviet Union which became independent in 1991, is the most developed country in the Central Asian region. The landlocked country with the 9th largest area in the world, has nearly 20 million people and has a percapita income of more than US \$ 10,000.

The existence of the Indonesian Corner at Kazakh Ablai Khan University International Relations and World Languages, in the city of Almaty, the largest city in Kazakhstan with a population of more than 2 million people, which is also nicknamed the student city, has a very strategic meaning for the internationalization of UPNVJ in Central Asia.
