HumasUPNVJ - In order to recruit prospective outstanding students with a strong religious background, Universitas Pembangunan Nasional "Veteran" Jakarta (UPNVJ) is again holding the Al-Qur'an Hafidz Skills Test as part of the 2025 Achievement Pathway Independent Selection (SEMA).

This activity took place on Saturday, June 28, 2025 at the Manbaul Ulum Mosque, UPNVJ Campus, and was attended by eight participants who had previously passed the administrative selection. This test aims to provide added value for participants in the SEMA selection process, especially those who have the ability to memorize the Quran.

One of the participants, Zaki Mubarak, from East Jakarta, shared his experience in taking the Al-Qur'an Hafidz skills test. He chose the Electrical Engineering and Mechanical Engineering Study Programs as his dream study programs.

"I have prepared myself by routinely memorizing the Quran before the exam. I was a little nervous when appearing in front of the judges, but I still tried my best to be accepted in the study program I wanted," said Zaki.
