

Chancellor Inaugurates 1,906 75th Graduates, Ready to Realize Golden Indonesia 2045

A total of 1,906 graduates from various faculties were officially inaugurated as bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees, ready to contribute to Indonesia Emas 2045.

UPNVJ's 75th graduation ceremony was attended by university leaders, lecturers, and the graduates' families.
