DWP UPNVJ Holds Community Service: Brain Gymnastics Education and Pain Relief Injections for the Elderly in Depok

Next, participants participated in brain gymnastics education, interactive games, and pain relief injection health services. The event concluded with a group prayer, in which the elderly enthusiastically participated.

This community service program emphasizes dementia prevention through simple, easy-to-implement daily activities. Brain gymnastics is designed to train cognitive function, while pain relief injections help reduce chronic pain in the elderly. The activities also strengthen the DWP UPNVJ's partnership with the surrounding community, particularly on the increasingly relevant issue of elderly health in Indonesia.

Rena Nantia Venus, Chair of the UPNVJ DWP, stated that this initiative aligns with the vision of a national defense campus. "UPNVJ is committed to supporting humanity through concrete actions, such as this community service, which not only improves the quality of life for seniors but also strengthens public health policies.
