

# UPNVJ Receives Rp79 Billion in Land Assets from the Ministry of Finance to Build a Teaching Hospital in Pasar Kemis

The Ministry of Finance handed over property assets from the former Indonesian Bank Restructuring Agency (IBRA) and the former Agency Under Liquidation, worth Rp79.6 billion, to the Ministry of Higher Education, Research, and Technology, to be managed by the Jakarta Veterans National Development University (UPNVJ). The handover ceremony, which involved signing a handover report, took place at the Ministry of Finance building. The 71,909 square meter land in Pasar Kemis, Tangerang, will be used to build a teaching hospital, laboratory, Faculty of Medicine, and/or Faculty of Health Sciences to improve public access to medical services and strengthen national higher education in the health sector.

This handover is part of the optimization of state assets to support the ministry's duties and accelerate human resource development. These assets are planned to be developed in stages starting in the 2026 fiscal year, encompassing technical planning, design, and physical construction.

Prof. Dr. Anter Venus, Rector of UPNVJ, stated, "The handover of these assets supports the government's policy of strengthening health education infrastructure. We are committed to building this trust to the best of our ability. Another goal is to develop quality facilities, thereby strengthening the nation's resilience to the challenges of national medical services.

The target date for the healthcare facility's operation is 2027 to 2028, in accordance with established infrastructure and operational standards. This step supports inter-institutional synergy for transparent and productive state asset management, while also addressing the need for quality healthcare services amidst a growing population.
