

# Roadshow Goes to Campus: UPNVJ Collaborates with Aktual.com and Sekolah Negarawan to Educate Media Literacy for Gen Z

The inaugural event, held at the UPNVJ Faculty of Medicine Building in Pondok Labu, South Jakarta, was attended by approximately 40 UPNVJ students, lecturers, and students from the Jakarta State Polytechnic (PNJ) and several other universities. The event aimed to provide media literacy education and share ideas on national issues and Indonesia's future, with the theme "Understanding a New Way of Viewing the Nation for Gen Z."

This roadshow is part of a series of visits by Aktual.com to ten public and private universities in the Greater Jakarta area from January to November 2026. Starting at UPNVJ, the event included interactive discussions to raise awareness among the younger generation about the state structure as a fundamental solution for national progress. This collaboration created a positive synergy between the media, research institutions, and students in amplifying the importance of national education.

The speakers shared perspectives on media literacy and statecraft ideas, emphasizing the role of Generation Z in improving the nation through a new understanding of the state.
